

Since the 1970s, the department has expanded from a small volunteer team to a force of 28 full-time employees, 40+ volunteers, and 20 emergency vehicles. To maintain operational efficiency, they needed a robust Inventory and Asset tracking system.

The Challenges of Managing Emergency Inventory and Equipment

Before implementing our software, Wintergreen Rescue & Fire faced several critical challenges:

- Limited Tracking: Difficulty managing inventory and assets across multiple locations, including on-site stations and emergency response vehicles.
- Manual Processes: Inventory tracking was time-consuming and prone to errors, affecting supply availability.
- Expiration Date Monitoring: Emergency medical supplies required strict expiration date tracking to ensure readiness and compliance.
- Inefficient Restocking: Lack of visibility into stock levels led to unnecessary orders or shortages.


These challenges prompted Wintergreen Rescue & Fire to seek a configurable and automated inventory and asset management solution.
